Tutor Criteria and Qualifications

Background

The CCNSG is seeking continuous improvement in the delivery of training courses leading to the award of the CCNSG Nationally Accredited Safety Passport. From 1st April 2005, **all Course tutors must be registered with the CCNSG Secretary and have completed The Scheme Induction Course before delivering the National Course training material.** A copy of the National and Renewal Course Tutor Registration form is enclosed. Each tutor is allocated a registration number to ensure that training is being delivered by an approved trainer.

Criteria and Qualifications

The criteria for tutors delivering the National and Renewal Course training material are:

- 1. The tutor must hold a health and safety qualification at least equivalent to the NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health.**
- 2. The tutor must have a sound working knowledge of the CCNSG Nationally Accredited Safety Passport scheme.**
- 3. The tutor must be an experienced trainer.**
- 4. The tutor must hold a CCNSG safety passport achieved by attendance on the National or Renewal Course using the material enclosed.**

All the above criteria will be audited under the CCNSG training provider audit scheme.
